Mission Statement:

The mission of Sidestreet Arts is to operate a visual arts venue that promotes, encourages, and supports the work of its members and guest artists. We value a positive environment to work, show art, and connect to the community.

Sidestreet Arts is owned and operated by member artists and democratically controlled with a Board of Directors and Committees that cover the day to day and long term needs and goals of SA.

Our purpose is to provide a place for member artists to exhibit and sell their work, to offer juried non-member artists a supportive place to show their work, and an opportunity for the community to view art in a welcoming environment.

Represented Artists – Small Works Gallery

Call is open to artists in all mediums.

The Board reviews new applications quarterly.

- After an initial 2 month period, Represented Artists may be invited to exhibit for an extended period.
- Represented Artists will show in Sidestreet Arts' cash-and-carry Small Works Gallery, and should plan on having extra items on hand to replace works as they sell.
- Works larger than 18 inches in any dimension will be considered on an individual basis.
- Represented Artists pay 40% commission, paid monthly.
- Represented Artists sign a contract with terms of their participation.
- Represented Artists are not required nor permitted to conduct gallery business such as add/remove inventory, conduct sales transactions, or sit gallery shifts.
- Represented Artists are expected to promote shows and their art through social media and an email list, and to attend gallery functions. Promotion of other artists is encouraged.
- Represented Artists will permit Sidestreet Arts to use images of their included work for promotional purposes.

Contracts

The board will oversee all contractual agreements, including but not limited to: SA Membership Contract and third party contracts.

Applying for Representation

- Applicants must submit 3 professional quality images of the work to be exhibited.
- Applicants must complete the online Represented Artists Application
- Applicants may be asked to interview with the SA board, and work may be subject to review by our member jury.
- Accepted applicants will be notified by email and telephone.

Social Media

- Members and Non-members will be expected to promote shows and their art via their social media, website and other promotional platforms.
- Promotion of other artists is encouraged, especially for group shows.
